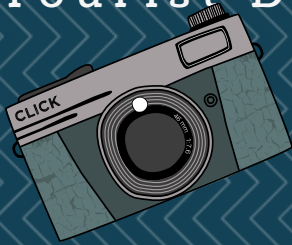

The 2018-2019 FAFSA application (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) became available on October 1, 2017. You must first create an FSA ID at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).
